

Studio Dress Code



Pre School/PreK Ballet and/or Combo Classes (Follow Dress Code for Ballet + your 1 other Genre)

Black or Pink Leotard
Pink leather ballet shoes
Tap Shoes should match skin tone
Bare Feet for Acro
Sneaker Shoe for Hip Hop (any style, child should be able to get on & off themself)
Skirt/Tutu/Spandex Shorts of any color - optional
Hair secured tightly

Ballet/Pointe Classes

Black Leotard
Pink tights
Pink canvas ballet shoes
Any color skirt - optional
No shorts
Hair secured tightly in a bun

Tap/Clogging Classes

Any color Leotard or Crop Top
Spandex Shorts or Leggings - optional
Tap shoes - match skin tone
Hair secured tightly

Contemporary/Jazz/Lyrical Classes

Any color Leotard
Any color Tank or Long Lined Crop Top
Spandex Shorts or Leggings
Hair secured tightly
Barefeet

Hip Hop Classes

Loose fitting top and/or loose fitting bottoms, any color
Hip hoppers should be in layers
Sneaker or Hip Hop style shoe (Must be worn for dance class only. No street shoes will be permitted)

Acro Classes

Any color Leotard or Crop Top
Spandex shorts or Leggings
No loose fitting clothing
Barefeet
Hair secured tightly

Ballroom Classes

Any color Leotard or Crop Top
Latin Skirt
Nude/Gold Latin Heel 1-1.5 inch or Ballroom Practice Shoes
Hair secured tightly
